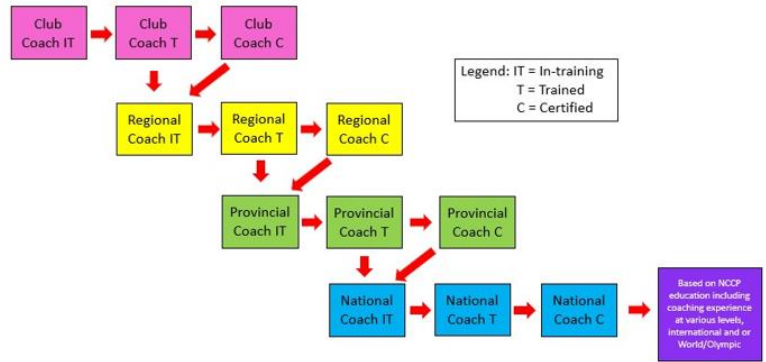


NEW NCCP Pathways – Streamlined 2019

Mission: To simplify the NCCP Pathway for Skate Canada coaches.

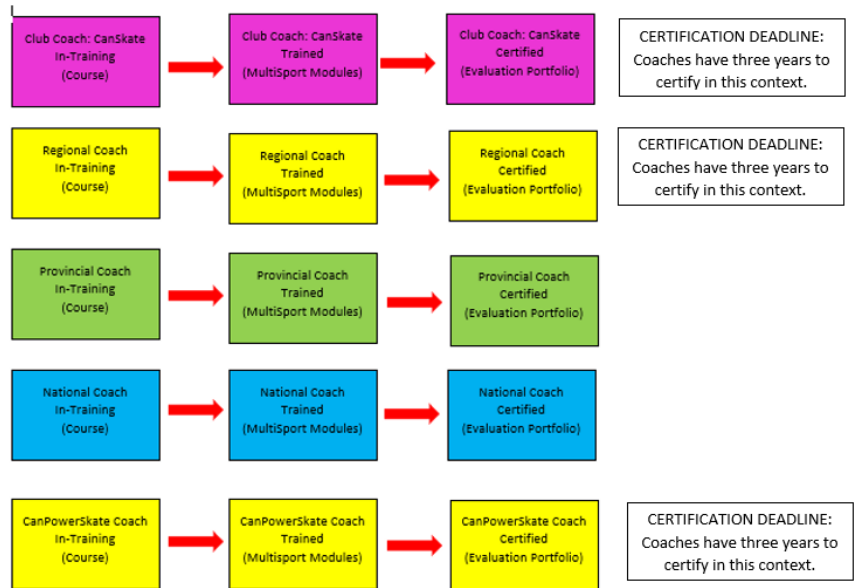
Challenges with current model:

- Multiple evaluations per context (level).
- This is costly and time consuming.
- Multiple entry points for Regional and Provincial contexts. This creates confusion.
- Deadlines for certification confusing with the multiple evaluations and entry points per context.



New Model (effective January 1, 2019):

- One evaluation per context
- Deadlines on the certification portfolio only for CanSkate, CanPowerSkate and Regional context only (the contexts related to programming)
- Participants are assigned and connected to a Coach Evaluator who will support their development through a mentorship role.
- Includes multisport modules in the “Trained” status, to allow for more sport – specific content during the “In-training” course.



Managing the transition:

- All coaches who have completed a portfolio to earn a TRAINED status in the 2012 CanSkate or 2018 Regional Coach context, will automatically be granted the CERTIFIED status, as they have already completed one evaluation in this context. CPS not affected as it is a new context and is already formatted in the new pathway.
- Coaches who have obtained a Trained Status without a practical evaluation (workbook only), will be required to complete the Certified portfolio.
