### **Registration Information**

#### 2019/2020 Season For Regional Host and Team Managers



The process for online registration will be very similar to last season. The Regional Host will be responsible for officially registering each Team. The Team Managers will be responsible for ensuring all Online Registration Forms are received by Skate Canada by all deadlines. This information sheet will give a breakdown of when all items are due to Skate Canada, and when you will receive certain items from Skate Canada. # **Registration Process**

- 1. Regional Host Section submit their Nationals Entry List using the template provided by Skate Canada, no later than 48 hours (midnight EST) following the completion of their Regional Championship.
  - a. Please note that the listing of Coaches, Choreographers and Team Managers should be those associated with the Team throughout the season, not necessarily those who are attending Nationals.
- Regional Hosts are asked to use the excel template provided to enter their complete entry list it contains drop down menus that can only be accessed if the information is entered electronically. Please do not handwrite and submit the entry list.
- 3. Team Managers will also have 48 hours (midnight EST) following the completion of their Regional Championship to complete their Team Registration Forms. See exact dates listed above.
  - a. Team Registration Form
  - b. <u>Short Program Planned Program Sheet (Junior and Senior only)</u>
  - c. Free Program Planned Program Sheet

Note: If there are changes to your Planned Programs after your submission, **please complete a new submission**. Your newest submission will be used.

- 4. Skaters will have 48 hours (midnight EST) following the submission of the Official Entry List to complete their individual registration.
  - a. Athlete Waivers

Detailed instructions for the Team Registration Form, as well as the Athlete Waivers will be posted on the Skate Canada <u>Info Centre</u>. Please familiarize yourselves with the Athlete Waivers in order to answer any questions your skaters may have.

- Junior and Senior: 16 skaters (+ 4 alternates)
