

COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH MEASURES

Masks are required when visiting indoor City facilities and while riding Regina Transit. The Government of Saskatchewan requires that individuals 12 years of age and over show proof of full vaccination or negative COVID-19 test for public access to a number of establishments, businesses and event venues including City of Regina facilities.

As a city facility, Regina Exhibition Association Limited (REAL) will align its proof of vaccination requirements at its facilities, including Co-operators Centre, with City policies. Find more details on [what to expect when visiting the REAL Campus Opens in new window.](#)

2022 SKATE CANADA CHALLENGE EVENT PROTOCOLS

- 1) All participants, over the age of 12, will be required to show proof of double vaccination status for a minimum of 14 days or a negative COVID test, not more the 72 hours prior to registration to receive their accreditation.
- 2) Physical distancing, as much as possible, in and around the venue.
- 3) Masks will be worn at all times, at the hotel, on the bus and the practice venue, with the exception of when eating or competing. The exception to this rule, is that individuals over the age of 18, who are unvaccinated; must keep their face masks on at all times, with no exceptions for competing.
- 4) Coughing, sneezing, hand washing/disinfecting protocols will be followed by all participants.
- 5) High touch areas will be disinfected after each competitor.
- 6) 1 coach at rink side per entry will be strictly followed.
- 7) Avoid unnecessary gathering/congregating, even in public concourses.
- 8) Participants are advised not arrive prior to their designated arrival times and asked to leave at the conclusion of their competition to avoid unnecessary crowding in the venue.
- 9) Victory Ceremonies will be conducted at the designated Kiss & Cry area, for each competition.

TRANSPORTATION

ARRIVALS

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation from the Regina International Airport to the Delta Hotel Regina and DoubleTree by Hilton starting on Monday, November 29, 2021. Transfers to and from the airport will be provided for **officials, event technicians, and streaming only**.

Please look for the Skate Canada volunteer greeters carrying signs once you exit the baggage area.

Should any guest's arrival be delayed for any reason, they are asked to inform the Transportation Desk (+1 613 914 5348) as soon as possible with the expected arrival time in Regina, so that arrangements can be modified.

DEPARTURES
