The app is available for download from the Apple Store (iPhone) and Google Play Store (Android).







COVID-19 VENUE HEALTH MEASURES

The well-being of team members, guests and community is of the utmost importance to us. Please note that as of midnight, February 9, 2022, the provincial Restrictions Exemption Program (REP) has ended.

Mandatory

Face covering (mask) is required in all common areas such as lobby, hallways, Seating area for Spectator and dressing rooms.

- Daily use of KN95/N95 are required AT ALL TIMES and will be provided by Skate Canada on site to all participants.
- Participants must be masked at all times, except during the training activity.
- Social Distancing
- Mask will be required for all patrons while not actively eating or drinking.

Lobby Area

- Limit of 3 people maximum per table for eating & drinking only. No mingling between tables.
- No Teams to use the lobby area to hang out, warm up or running in lobby area's

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

OFFICIALS & SKATE CANADA GUESTS ARRIVALS

The Organizing Committee will only provide transfers to and from Calgary International Airport for officials, event technicians, streaming, Skate Canada staff and Board Members.

Please look for the Skate Canada volunteer greeters once you exit the baggage area.

Should any guest's arrival be delayed for any reason, they are asked to inform the Transportation Desk (1.613.325.2154) as soon as possible with the expected arrival time in Calgary, so that arrangements can be modified.

DEPARTURES

The airport departures at the conclusion of the event will be managed by a departure list with times, which will be available and posted at the Transportation Desk at Seven Chiefs Sportsplex. Coordinate directly with the Transportation Desk, no later than 24 hours before your pick-up time if you need to change the time of your transportation to the airport.

- 1. All skaters must submit music online as part of the registration process.
- 2. Music will only be accepted electronically via **MP3 format**. Do not begin the registration process until you have your music file ready to upload.
- 3. Competitors must have their back-up file either USB flash drive or CD at the boards during official practice and/or competition.
- 4. Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc., will not be accepted for playing music.
